

Bounty Bags - this sale project is a seed money fund raiser for the 50th anniversary of CEG. We did it for the evening anniversary and it went really well so we would like to try it in day as well. (Jan 22 evening/25 day)

It is based on the premise that we all have lots of stuff, whether multiples of things we like to do or things we are ready to part with.

So..... You take a large freezer zip bag and you make a co-ordinated package of stuff.

Co-ordinated in that you make a package of stuff that would all work together. For example.

1. a black work package – with some aida cloth, black floss, ? needle/small pattern to work from. Put a label on it saying blackwork.
2. A selection of batiks and some coordinating threads
3. Scrapbooking supplies – paper, die cuts, embellishments
4. Knitting that you never got around to – yarn, needles, pattern
5. Dyed yarns or fabric package with some matching threads
6. Some canvas, some floss or wool, a tapestry needle, ? stitch pages or a project sheet. – label canvas work

We invite everyone to make at least one bag. You get to part with stuff but you could end up with most of the supplies to try something new to you.

They are sold for \$5.00 per bag – so it is a bit like a trade – everyone can get one bag each and then any remaining bags can be purchased.
