A Modern Take on Penny Quilts - Tammy Sparling

Inspiration day this year is going to be really special!

We will have fun learning the ancient, but thoroughly modern skill, of “Penny Quilts”. Today’s penny quilts have evolved from rugs to much more: wall hangings, table runners, pictorial pieces or even incorporated into hand bags. They are made using a variety of stitches and motifs of all kinds from whimsical to Christmas inspired to classic layered circles. Our teacher, Tammy Sparling, (an expert in this technique) will take you through the process from start to finish.

You will create your own small Penny Quilt using felted wools provided in the kit, with extra selections available within the kit fee. The piece will be roughly 5” x 7”.

As usual we will have delicious soups, breads and our great assortment of cookies for lunch along with tea, coffee and goodies at 2 break periods.

So mark this date on your calendar and get ready for a wonderful mid-winter break.
The fee of \$35.00 will cover the instruction, the kit fee (felted wool pieces) and lunch.

Supplies not included in the kit fee that you will require are:

A variety of colours of threads to the weight of pearl cotton or lace weight yarns, beads, needles, pins, scissors.
