In the past, the works of textile art are voted on by the membership at the Spring Budget Meeting and Pot Luck for Day Group.

This year, we were not able to gather and have your work on display. However, the President's Challenge, 2020 will still be held. A photo of your entry will be submitted and all submissions will be judged during a virtual meeting later this fall.

The winner, determined by popular vote by members, will receive a one-year membership for either Day Group or Evening Group when we re-convene after Covid-19. While there is only one top prize, all who enter a piece will receive a prize.

My challenge is for you to create a wearable embellishment using any technique(s) you choose.

Your piece must not be an article of clothing but an adornment such as earrings, brooch, bracelet, hair barrette, or necklace. Repurposing is encouraged.

The item must include some gold bling in honour of our 50th, as well as, something blue incorporated into the design.
