Welcome to the Canadian Embroiderers' Guild, London. In this, our 47th year, the Guild hopes that it will continue to provide a setting for all members to stitch, share ideas, enjoy the companionship of people with common interests and be the very best embroiderers and fabric artists we can be.

### **General Information**

CEG, London, exists for its members and operates through the dedication of its members. All positions held are strictly voluntary.

There are two groups that comprise the Guild – the Day Group and the Evening Group – and both meet at Wesley-Knox United Church in London, September through April. You may join either group or both.

The **Day Group** meets most Thursdays, with the majority of classes being held on the second and fourth Thursdays. The library is open from 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Class days on second and fourth Thursdays begin with announcements at 9:30 a.m., followed by classes until 12:00 p.m. and lunch from 12:00 p.m. to 1:00 p.m. An Afternoon Program follows lunch and may consist of a speaker, a demonstration, a sale or a Guild meeting. The Guild day usually ends around 2:30 p.m. Full-day classes and special events are held on first Thursdays. "Let's Gather and Stitch" days, held on the third Thursday of the month, 9:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m., are an opportunity for informal stitching in a social environment.

The **Evening Group** meets at the church on the second and fourth Monday evenings of the month. The library opens at 6:45 p.m., announcements are made at 7:00 p.m., and classes run from 7:15 to 9:30 p.m.

Separate calendars for the Day Group and the Evening Group are part of this registration package. **It is particularly important that you read the relevant 2018-19 calendar(s) carefully and watch for email and website notices throughout the year about changes to meeting dates, times, and/or locations.**

The Guild also offers an **Associate Membership** for those unable to attend regular meetings and classes.

**All Guild memberships** include the use of the Guild's library, access to the Members' only pages of the website, and eligibility to attend Afternoon Programs, Let's Gather and Stitch days, Inspiration Day, Guildsponsored workshops, Winter Retreat, Summer Workshop and all special events.

There are a number of social events during the year, including Winter Retreat, that provide additional opportunities for stitching and companionship. As well, the Guild participates in outreach programs that afford members the opportunity to contribute to the broader community: "Knitting for the Needy" (hats, scarves, mitts for Salvation Army); "Bag Ladies" who sew mastectomy bags for cancer patients at area hospitals; and a group that provides stitching instruction at My Sisters' Place.
